

CONVENING SPACE RESERVATION AND USAGE POLICY

Co.act Detroit Convening Space, Standard Reservation Hours

Co.act Detroit Convening Space, After Hours Reservations

After hours reservations at Co.act Detroit can be made by special request, those requests will be evaluated on a case by case basis by Co.act Detroit's staff. After hours reservations may result in additional costs.

- Tues Fri 5:30 pm- 8:00pm
- Saturday 10:00 am 2:00pm

Reservations and Cancellations

- Convening and meeting spaces require a non-refundable security deposit equal to a (1) hour rental charge for the reserved space(s). Your security deposit will be applied to your rental fee.
- Payments for all convening space bookings must be paid in full prior one week before the event/meeting date.
- Cancellations made within 1 week of your event/meeting date will incur a 50% charge of your total rental fee.
- Cancellations must be made in writing via email to <u>reservations@coactdetroit.org.</u>
- All setup and attendance information must be confirmed 5 business days prior to event or meeting date.
- Reservations will be accepted thru December 31, 2019 and must be requested 5 business days prior to your event/meeting.
- All setup and attendance information must also be confirmed 5 business days prior to your event/meeting. Additional setup changes after the 5-day period may result in additional charges.
- Standard rental rates include 6 ft. tables, chairs, projector and/or monitor (see room details). Special furniture, linens and other furnishings not included in the standard room setup options may result in additional charges.
- Additional cleaning, security & staff fees may also apply and are at the discretion of Co.act Detroit staff.
- Michigan Law Requires any event *with fees* to acquire a special permit for the sale or consumption of alcohol. Events that *are free of charge* for attendees may serve alcohol.

Food and Beverage | Catering

Co.act Detroit does not provide in-house food services, nor do we have a direct affiliation with a catering service. Our convening space includes a kitchenette with an island and typical appliances, and it's suitable for an outside caterer to stage and serve food. The space does *not* include any commercial kitchen equipment, nor does it support food prep or cooking. All catered food must be prepared off-site in advance. Warming / chafing dishes are allowed for food service.

If your event requires catering, we ask that you provide us with basic information on your caterer / food provider in advance of your event. At Co.act Detroit, we believe that local, independent businesses play an integral role in the vitality of neighborhoods and cities - we encourage our meeting partners to consider local providers when planning your event.

Beverage service that consists of filtered water, regular coffee & decaf coffee as well as an assortment of teas is available for a nominal fee.
